Protected as a geographical indication of the European Union, only fruit spirits mashed, distilled, matured and bottled in Hungary and similar apricot spirits from four provinces of Austria can be called „pálinka”. While pálinka may be made of any locally grown fruit, the most common ones are plums, apricots, apples, pears, and cherries.
